Uncovered storage of salt is forbidden by Massachusetts General Law Chapter 85, section 7A in areas that would threaten water supplies. The Drinking Water Regulations, 310 CMR 22.21(2)(b), also restrict deicing chemical storage within wellhead protection areas (Zone I and Zone II) for public water supply wells, as follows: "storage of sodium chloride, chemically treated abrasives or other ...

Determining accurate storage requirements in SQL Server is an ongoing process that you should repeat regularly throughout the life of the database application. The first time to decide how much storage you'll need is during the development phase of the database application's life span, before the QA and production hardware is ordered.
